

PARK RULES

(Updated October 28, 2011)

RELEASE FORMS

- A. ALL RIDERS must read and execute the Waiver of Liability and Release Forms prior to participating in any Park activity or using any of the Park facilities, Equipment, or courses.
- B. ALL riders under the age of (18) must have the proper Waiver of Liability and Release Form executed by the rider's Natural Guardian (as defined by Florida Statutes). If you are bringing a minor child, and you are not the Natural Guardian of said child, you must bring a properly executed WAIVER of Liability and Release Form executed by the minor child's Natural Guardian. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS to this requirement.
- C. The mandated Waiver of Liability and Release Forms are available for review and may be downloaded from the park's website.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- (1) ALL RIDERS AND PASSENGERS MUST WEAR A FULL FACE DOT APPROVED HELMET AND OFF ROAD GOGGLES.
- (2) SIDED BY SIDES AND FOUR WHEEL ATVS WITH FULL FENDERS MUST WEAR A BOOT THAT COVERS THE ANKLES. ALL RIDERS RIDING FOUR WHEELERS MADE FOR RACING OR DIRT BIKES MUST WEAR OFF ROAD MOTORCROSS STYLE BOOTS, NO EXCEPTIONS.

PARK RULES

- (1) -- THIS PARK IS ONLY FOR DIRT BIKES, 4 WHEEL ATVS AND SIDE BY SIDES.
- (2) -- RIDER AGE--- UNDER 5 CAN NOT RIDE
 - 5 TO 12 -- UP TO 115 cc
 - 13 TO 15 -- 116 TO 249
 - 16 AND OLDER -- 250 AND UP
- (3) -- ***WE NO LONGER REQUIRE A SPARK ARRESTOR IF YOU DON'T HAVE ONE.***
- (4) -- NO WALKING, RUNNING, OR BIKE RIDING ON TRAILS.
- (5) -- ALL TRAILS ARE (1) ONE WAY.
- (6) -- WE HAVE ZERO TOLERANCE FOR DRUGS AND ALCOHOL.
- (7) -- NO FIRES EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED AREAS.
- (8) -- PETS MUST BE CAGED OR ON A 6 FOOT LEASH AT ALL TIMES.
- (9) -- DOUBLE RIDING--- WE RECOMMEND FOLLOWING THE MANUFACTURERS GUIDELINES.
- (10) -- SERVICE ROADS ARE 10 MILES PER HOUR AND UNDER AND ARE (2) WAY.
- (11) -- THREE WHEELED VEHICLES ARE NOT ALLOWED.
- (12) -- ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR THE PARK ISSUED WRISTBANDS.
- (13) -- ***WE ARE NO LONGER CONCERED ABOUT THE SOUND TEST OF 96db. OUR NEIGHBORS HAVE NO COMPLAINTS ABOUT SOUND. THAT'S A GOOD THING.***
- (14) STAY OFF PRIVATE LAND.
- (15) NO SMOKING OUTSIDE OF CAMPING AREA.
- (16) STAY ON TRAILS AND ONLY ENTER AND EXIT WHERE IT IS MARKED TO DO SO.

RULE UPDATES (AS OF OCTOBER 28, 2011)

RULE # 3---WE NO LONGER REQUIRE A SPARK ARRESTOR IF YOU DON'T HAVE ONE.

RULE # 13--- WE ARE NO LONGER CONCERNED ABOUT SOUND TEST OF 96db. OUR NEIGHBORS HAVE NO COMPLAINTS ABOUT SOUND.THAT'S A GOOD THING.

WE DO HOPE THAT THESE TWO RULE CHANGES HELP IN THE EXPENSE OF RIDING OFF ROAD FOR YOU ALL.

LAST BUT NOT LEAST...HELMETS AND SAFETY GEAR

ALL DIRT BIKE RIDERS MUST WEAR: FULL FACE HELMET, PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR, FULL MOTOCROSS BOOTS.

4 WHEEL / SIDE BY SIDE / GULF CARTS:

ALL MINORS (AGE 17 AND UNDER) MUST WEAR: FULL FACE HELMET, EYE PROTECTION, ANY BOOT THAT COVERS THE ANKLE.

***** IF YOU ARE 18 AND OLDER AND CHOOSE NOT TO WEAR PROTECTIVE GEAR YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN AN ADDITIONAL WAIVER. WE RECOMMEND THAT YOU WEAR PROTECTIVE GEAR, BUT THE CHOICE IS YOURS, AND ANY INJURY RECEIVED AS A RESULT OF YOUR CHOICE IS ON YOU AND YOU ALONE.**

SOON WE WILL HAVE A LOW IMPACT MX TRACK FOR 4 WHEELERS AND DIRT BIKES. IN ORDER TO RIDE THE MX TRACK, YOU MUST HAVE FULL FACE HELMET---GOGGLES AND MOTOCROSS BOOTS, NO EXCEPTIONS.
